Subject :- Defence Procurement Manual (DPM – 2006) – Amendment - III

DPM 2006 provides for Integrity Pact for purchases exceeding Rs.100 crore. The details of the Integrity Pact provisions are at Article 23.3 of the RFP as part of the standard conditions of contract. The following two clauses are hereby added as clauses (i) & (j) to Para 23.3 :-

- 23.3 (i) The draft Pre-Contract Integrity Pact is attached as Appendix R. The vendors are required to sign them and submit separately along with the technical and commercial offers.
- (j) Every Bidder while submitting techno commercial bid shall also deposit \_\_\_ Crores as earnest Money / Security Deposit though any of the instruments mentioned at Para 8 of Appendix R. This would be submitted in a separate envelope clearly marked as Earnest Money Deposit along with technical and commercial proposals.
